Properties bordering Munster on the east Frank spoke about the property north of Bleeks, behind Butterfield, believed to be owned by the Jongejan family, and also the Sample property, south of Bleeks, behind Coldstream. Many years ago Munsterites unofficially accessed both of these areas in respectful ways, such as walking, tobogganing, and cross country skiing. Then a few years ago the Sample property was fenced off and posted with No Trespassing signs because some people (not necessarily Munsterites) were abusing the properties in various ways, including dumping. Some of the same abuse has become apparent in the Jongejan property in the last few years. Frank said it is something the MCA ought to think about and possibly intervene so that the closing of the Jongejan property might be avoided. Dave suggested that an Environmental position on the board, to ask Munsterites to respect neighbouring properties, someone to liaison with the landowners, as well as to clean up Munster such as the boulevards by liasing with the city as is currently being done.
